Notes for ANGUS BELL:

Angus was born in Scotland in Killarrow on the Isle of Islay located off the west coast of Scotland. Shortly after immigrating to America in about the year 1832 at the approximate age of 13 years, he settled in Upper Canada in the Township of Innisfil and West Gwillimbury.

Angus Bell is shown as being a "conveyancer, issuer of marriage licenses and Township Clerk of Nottawasaga, Twp., coroner." He was the Township Clerk from 1850 until his death in 1897.

From the Creemore Star (newspaper), Village of Singhampton in 1889, written by J.B. Spurr, Editor:

"In 1846 he (Angus) settled on the lot which has seen the rise and progress of the village of Singhampton."

There were a number of family photographs taken probably in the early part of her visit probably in the February-April time frame. Jack Strachan, who is in the photographs, appears to be about six months old.)

From The Advertiser, (newspaper) December 29, 1927.

"Obituary - Mrs. Catharine Bell. On December 21st, 1927, after a lingering illness at the residence of her daughter, Mrs. J.S. Higgins, Scott St., Islington, Catharine Riddell in her 74th year. The funeral service was held at the above address on Thursday at 8 p.m.. Interment was made at Singhampton on Saturday. (Mrs. J.S. Higgins was in fact Mrs. J.E. Higgin, which would be Catharine's daughter, Pearl, from her marriage to George F. Riddell.)

Notes for GEORGE FRANCIS RIDDELL:

From the Collingwood Bulletin, dates as listed.

March 30, 1900 - "G.F. Riddell has gone to the Soo, where he will saw and hammer this summer. - - Contractor N. McLean is also going west. - - Why don't some of the loafers go?". (Most likely George was joining his son, Augustine, who at this time was working and living in the Soo with his wife Mary J. Hanna.)

October 13, 1921 - "On Tuesday, Oct 4th, this village and section lost one of its oldest residents, in the person of Mr. George Riddell, (Riddell) who died at his home in the village. Mr. Riddell had not been well for some time, still had been confined to his home but a week prior to his death. He had lived in this vicinity for many years and had a wide circle of friends and acquaintances. Deceased is survived by his wife, four daughters and two sons. One son, William was killed overseas. The funeral took place (place) Thursday to the Union Cemetery, the services being conducted by Rev. A. Lang, pastor of the Presbyterian church." (The two sons would have been Frank and Oscar and the daughters would have been Georgina, Catherine, Elizabeth and Pearl. None of George's children from his first marriage are included. Sept 3,2002 - "A couple of weeks ago, I was in the Collingwood library where I checked the All Saint's Anglican Cemetery listing. It was a new listing and the surprising thing was that this listing did not have John Taylor or his son Henry listed. During my Monday Sept 2 visit to the cemetery, I came across the caretaker and told him who I was looking for and the problem of the two conflicting listings. He knew right away who I was looking for and asked me if I was the person who had been in touch with the Church. Of course that was you, Randy. He took me over to the spot that he had identified as being the location of the grave-a site without a stone. I pulled out the old listing I had and we agreed that this spot didn't make sense as being correct. We went over to his truck, he had the new listing which also didn't fit the spot he had picked -he phoned his office for them to verify my old listing and than we went out there to look again. I spotted a stone that was on my list and all of a sudden realized that the direction of the stones went off in an east west direction where they are normally south to north. We followed each stone in order of my listing and there was still another stone to look at in that row and it turned out to be Henry's!!!! It is in very poor condition and most of it is unreadable being of that soft white stone they used in those days. There is a fair amount of lichen and black fungus on the stone. The caretaker started scrapping it with a knife which was only making matters worse. I asked him to stop and told him we would use soap and water along with a brush. We tried to do a rubbing but didn't have the correct paper or pencil. There is also another large stone at this place which is in real bad shape but it could be John's. The caretaker was going to get someone else to look at it."

POLICE CONTINUE CLOSE INQUIRY IN HIGHWAY TRAGEDY - Young Woman Killed on Falling From Cab of Moving Truck. Had Been Given Lift By Driver-No Eye Witnesses.

Provincial police are continuing their investigation and an autopsy is being performed on instructions from Dr. J. H. Mullen, chief coroner, into the death of Margaret (Marguerite) Robinson, 22, of this city, who was injured fatally early last evening when she fell from the cab of a truck as it was climbing Ancaster mountain on highway No. 2, just opposite Westmount Memorial cemetery. Sergeant S. H. Bush, of provincial headquarters, said that details of the inquiry would be reported this afternoon to George W. Ballard, K.C., crown attorney, and that, in the meantime, Eugene Rose, provincial highway traffic officer, was making a farther examination of the truck involved. It is being held at Bailey garage pending further inquiries. The young woman had been staying at the King George hotel here since April 17, and was said to have been going to Delhi to seek work when the mishap occurred.

Was Given Lift

Harold McMullen, driver of the truck, owned by the M. and A. Transport company, Delhi, stated that he had picked up the young woman at Dundum and Main streets. She had told him, that she wished to go to Delhi to look for work. She

had no luggage. Traffic Officers David Rogers and Eugene Rose investigated the accident but were at a loss to know whether the fatal injuries were suffered when the woman fell out onto the road, or if one of the wheels passed over her body. There were no marks on the truck and no eyewitnesses. Miss Robinson was alive when the truck stopped. The driver hailed a passing transport driven by Gordon Hounslow, Brantford, and he took the injured woman to Bailey's garage, where first aid was rendered. Dr. R. G. Fraser, Westdale was called but Miss Robinson passed away from terrible body injuries soon after he arrived. Dr. J. Heurner Mullin, chief coroner, inspected the scene of the accident.

Miss Robinson was born in Vinemount and had resided in the district all her life. Besides her mother, Mrs. William J. Robinson, of Fruitland, she leaves three sisters, Mrs. William St. John, in Hamilton; Mrs. C. R. Stapley, Smithville, and Mrs. Edward Harrison, of Pontiac, Mich., and two brothers, William, in Toronto, and Angus, of Kitchener. The funeral will be held from the Lorne G. Wallace funeral home on Friday afternoon at 2 o'clock, thence to Hamilton cemetery for interment."

"That brought to mind the wedding announcement of Mom and Dad that said they were going to live at 463 Algonquin after their marriage, so I just called Mom to ask about it. She said they never did live with Lester and Grace. They rented an upstairs apartment first, on a street that she can't remember. Then they rented a house on Eastlawn, then rented at 5039 Lakepointe, where they were when I was born (1938), then moved to another rented house on Lakewood. Then Dad built the house on 60 Hawthorn Blvd in 1941. She could not remember any of the street numbers, but I have a letter addressed to them at the 5039 Lakepointe address. I had no idea that they lived in so many places before Hawthorne, or that they were renting rather than buying. I had just assumed that they lived in a house built by Dad and Lester. Wrong! Another thing she mentioned that I didn't remember is that Lester and Grace moved to Grosse Pointe after Mom and Dad. She thought about a year, making their move from Algonquin to Hawthorn in 1942." We later learned the actual sequence and addresses of where Harold and Margaret Lived.
